### Illinois Federation of Republican Women (www.ifrw.org) 2011 Procedure for Nomination to State Office

#### Applications due: July 12, 2019

- 1) All correspondence, emails, phone calls must be directed to Nominating Committee Chairperson, Shelly Hranka, PO Box 233, Tremont IL 61568, Cell 309/256-2613. [shelly.hranka@gmail.com](mailto:shelly.hranka@gmail.com) All Applications will be reproduced and sent to Nominating Committee members.
- 2) Applications may be for a specific position or for a leadership position in general. The Committee will choose one nominee for each position: President, 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup> Vice President, Secretary, Treasurer (seven positions in total.) The slate of officers will be presented to the current IFRW Board to be announce at the October Convention in Peoria IL October 18th and 19th.
- 3) No forms are provided. Applicants are asked to submit a **maximum of 2 typed pages**:

One page describing key personal characteristics that have prepared you for a leadership role in IFRW;  
One page describing your thoughts on key goals and strategy for IFRW 2020-2021.

*This exercise is not a quiz!* There are no preconceived right or wrong answers. The Nominating Committee asks that you thoughtfully consider the importance of the IFRW to the success of the Republican Party and your role as a potential leader. Each applicants must be a 2019 member of IFRW in a chartered 2019 club.

#### Page 1

List all contact information. List in order your preference for position(s).

Describe the leadership characteristics which have made you a successful leader.

Give two examples of how you have used your leadership skills to lead a group to an accomplishment. (Be very specific in describing your skills and your role in each case.)

List three references with phone numbers: one government officeholder, one political organization officeholder, and one President or past President of your club.

#### Page 2

What do you see as the key mission of the IFRW?

Evaluate the work done by the IFRW Board in the last two years to work toward this mission.

Evaluate the work done toward this mission regarding the position for which you are applying.

List your three top goals for the IFRW 2020-2021. Describe and explain specific strategies and tactics for reaching these goals.

- 4) Interviews will be conducted in Springfield Thursday, August 15 and Friday, August 16. You must be present to be interviewed on one of these dates.
